TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENROLMENT FOR APPRENTICES
ENROLLING WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF BOLTON

Important Notice: Set out below are the University of Bolton's Terms & Conditions of Enrolment for all students who wish to study at the University. These Conditions of Enrolment together with the University's Student Admissions Policy, Course Fees Policy and other Rules, Regulations and other provisions and requirements and other policies and procedures of the University which apply to students will form an essential part of the contract between the University of Bolton and you (the student). If you are a continuing student you will be required to make yourself aware of the most recent version of these documents and to read and accept for each year of your study the current version of these Terms & Conditions of Enrolment, which will be an update to your continuing contract.

As part of the enrolment process, you will be asked to carefully read and understand each condition below. The enrolment process will be concluded once you have ticked the acceptance box to indicate your agreement to these Terms & Conditions of Enrolment and the University will then confirm to you completion of your enrolment to study. If you decline to accept these Condition of Enrolment you will not be considered as enrolled and you will be considered as wishing to terminate your contract with the University – in which case you will not be entitled to attend classes and/or have access to the University's services and facilities.

Below are the statements that you will be asked to read and accept as conditions of your enrolment at the University of Bolton and common to all annually reviewed and updated Terms & Conditions of Enrolment for each Academic Year.
